DOES PUBLIC CHARGE APPLY TO YOU?

Everyone's situation is different, and we want you to have the best information for you and your family.

In immigration law, "public charge" describes certain immigrants who use certain government programs. You may have heard that public charge rules can affect your immigration status if you

use programs like Medical Assistance (MA), SNAP or the Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP). If you want to know if these rules apply to you, talk to a lawyer.
