As we enter into a new decade, I am proud to see VEAP advocate for everyone's right to healthy, nutritious food and affordable housing—especially people earning low incomes or those unable to work because of age or disability.



In 2019, visits to our On-site Food Pantry reached record highs. Thanks to you, we distributed 4,333,522 pounds of food to families, individuals, seniors and children, a full 20 percent more than all of 2018. That's higher than our previous record in 2017 by nearly 600,000 pounds. While we are honored to serve so many families in our community—and to have the internal capacity thanks to our volunteers and staff to distribute so much food—the growing needs of our visitors remain a challenging constant.

VEAP's team is laser-focused on pulling the highest levers possible to ease families' financial stress, and to achieve that, we do so much more than just food distribution. Our model holistically addresses our visitors' needs: How can we support them with housing resources? Can we connect them with additional assistance for childcare, transportation, and health care? How can we problem solve with them, extending kindness and compassion while doing so?

2019 PROGRAM UPDATES



Food and Basic Needs VEAP's On-site and Mobile Food Pantries provide access to high quality, healthy, and fresh foods for low-income and food insecure households.

- 4.3 million pounds of food distributed to 139,280 individuals, our biggest year on record since our opening in 1973.
- 11,888 Mobile Food pantry visits at seven convenient sites
- 3,496 student weekend food packs handed out to local youth.
- 3,866 rides homes from the Food Pantry and
 119 senior shuttle rides provided.
- 390 healthy, fresh food deliveries made to those without transportation.

Social Services VEAP's team of social workers, community health advocates and housing specialists provides caring, professional support to people experiencing food insecurity, high-risk of eviction or homelessness, and financial crisis.

• 1,237 case management assessments completed.

• \$147,788 in emergency rent assistance granted to families and individuals to avoid eviction and homelessness.

- **311** individuals at risk of homelessness received rent assistance.
- \$1,164 average amount of assistance given.
- 23 individuals received car repair assistance and 532 gas and bus cards were distributed.




